The Problem

America's political system is not broken by accident. Two parties that have governed for over a century have engineered the system against competition, accountability, and change. The result: historic distrust, record-high independent voters, and a country accelerating into the AI age without a credible plan for what happens to the people left behind.

The division is not a side effect. It is a business model. Media monetizes outrage. Algorithms feed anger. Consultants win by making the other side unthinkable. Behind all of it, an economic elite that profits when the public is too fractured to organize.

This is not a drill. This is the trajectory — and it does not have to be inevitable.

Our Answer

The United Party is a new political force built platform-first — not around a candidate, not around a celebrity, but around real structures designed to outlast whoever holds office. We are not asking you to trust us. We are asking you to evaluate the design.

Five Pillars

The Service. National Civil and Military Service. Housing, healthcare, and a living stipend from day one. Three-day work week. Fully funded education. Complete your term — zero income tax for life. The structural answer to AI displacement, ready before it hits.

A New Economic Contract. End property tax on your home. Close every corporate loophole. The larger the institution, the greater its obligation. Direction: phased elimination of personal income tax — funded by collecting what is already owed.

The Intelligence Frontier. Publicly owned AI infrastructure — open-source models, public compute, independent safety testing — so the most transformative technology in history belongs to everyone. Not just whoever can afford it.

The Accountability Architecture. The Office of Public Integrity — constitutionally independent, empowered to investigate any official, publish findings in real time, and trigger a Popular Vote for removal. Including the president. The Director cannot be fired by the executive. The design makes the promise.

The Final Frontier. Permanent presence on the Moon. Permanent habitation on Mars. American citizenship travels with every American who carries it beyond this planet. Not a science program. A civilizational commitment.

What This Means for You

Join the Service: housing, healthcare, and a living stipend from day one. Complete your term and pay zero income tax for life. Working and don't join? Your income tax goes down anyway — funded by closing corporate loopholes. Own your home? Property tax ends. Own a small business? Your rate drops. Worried about AI? The Service is your safety net and public AI infrastructure is your equalizer. A veteran? Your service is honored and extended. Don't trust the government? Good — we built the OPI so you don't have to trust anyone, including us.

What We Do First

1. Build the accountability architecture — the OPI comes first because nothing works without trust
 2. Launch the Civil Service — infrastructure Americans can see, touch, and verify
 3. Close corporate tax loopholes — fund the Service and start reducing individual tax burdens
 4. Stand up public AI — the technology is not waiting and neither are we
 5. Introduce constitutional amendments — Digital Rights, Ranked Choice Voting, OPI recognition

Why Us

Platform before candidate. We built around ideas specific enough to organize, donate, and vote for — regardless of who runs.

Honest about what's hard. Building at this scale will not be simple, and we are not pretending it will be. A party that claims to have all the answers before governing has not been paying attention.

Institutions, not promises. The OPI cannot be dismantled by whoever wins next. The Service cannot be killed by a hostile Congress. We build things that outlast us.

Neither left nor right — honestly. Service and accountability are traditionally conservative. Public AI and tax restructuring are traditionally progressive. We own that combination because reality does not sort into two boxes.

The Numbers

- 62% of Americans say the two major parties fail badly enough to require a third option — near the all-time high (Gallup)
 - 45% identify as political independents — the highest share ever recorded (Gallup)
 - The two major parties are tied at 27% each in party identification
 - AI-driven labor displacement is already underway; the steepest curve arrives within the next decade
